As he looked through its lens he was amazed at the detail and beauty of crystals and the petals of flowers. He was so impressed with the instrument that he decided to purchase one and take it back to China. He thoroughly enjoyed using his microscope; however, one day he discovered something that disturbed him greatly. As he examined some rice he was planning to eat for dinner he found that tiny living creatures were crawling in it. Troubled by this he concluded that there was only one thing he could do.
