Following is an actual e-mail report from a church leader in Honduras. Chris Pipes (from Edgemere) has stayed in this man's house when their group traveled there on a mission trip. It is Chris that sent this to me. Here it is just as I received it:

I am infinitely grateful with God for having saved my life. Yesterday when I was on my way back from Amacuapa at 2:46 p.m. a gray truck intercepted when I was about to get the community of El Ocote.

Three armed men got out of the truck pointing at me with guns; they forced me to drive my truck way back to San Francisco de la Paz. Next they ordered me to pull over and pass to the passenger seat and so one of them took the wheel. Then they covered my eyes and later on they got me into another car and kept on driving through the paved road, then I felt that they deviated to a dirt road for a while. Then they stopped and turned off the engine. As soon as they got out they told me to get out too, and so they ordered me just to walk, but since my eyes were covered I could not see so they took me from the hand and led me through a trail where I was hitting against the thorny bushes which scratched my arms and after walking they told me to lie down to the ground. I said Lord this is my end and so I cried out: Lord thanks for my life thanks for giving it to me. Send your angels to save my life and touch their hearts

They talked to each other and then in secret. They pulled out their guns and wanted to use them, but they told me to sit. I said to myself they are going to kill me sitted. But I continued to pray to God giving thanks for all He had given to me and to forgive me if I had not done something well. They after asked me to stand up for a minute I thought they are going to kill me while standing. Again he told me to sit down, and one of them got behind me, there I also thought they would finish with my life. In those agonic moments I could only remind myself of my children, my wife, my mother, and my brothers... I heard that people passed through a way, cars and motorcycles besides I heard the sound of a river. After a couple of hours they told me to walk through the same trail. I heard a voice that told me to stop and lie down. Again I thought they are going to kill me... but my prayers to God continued. They kept on making calls and talking in secret to each other. When an hour had passed I heard a car coming and I could recognize because of the sound I knew that it was the same one in which we came. Then I heard that they called one of the bandits and told the other that their boss had said that they were coming to pick them up. And then they told me to stand that we are leaving, in that moment, God gave me strength and I told them "God loves you all" and one of them replied thanks. Then I told them to please tell me where is the north and the south so I can orient myself. I thought here they are going to leave me and I don't know where I was since my eyes were covered. And one of them responded don't you worry the boss told us to take you to a nearby location so you may ask for quick help. I know that the boss that led my deliverance was the great boss, our Lord and Savior. So then they ordered me to walk but since I could not see one of the bandits took me from the hand and led me through, when we got to the edge of the road there was the car. They ordered me get in quickly. And they put me in the back of the car, I tough they had put me in the back seat to throw me to the edge of an abyss. Then they stopped, because the car made a weird sound, so they got out to check, I heard one of them say it is the exhaust that is loose and so they kept
