Preacher's Porch



Well, it's time for one of my favorite subjects again. While I understand that sometimes you can beat a dead horse, I just had something driven home to me yesterday. Now, to set the stage, you know that I am training for a marathon. Because of this, I went out for a relatively long run vesterday. When I was checking all of my statistics afterward, it hit me. You see, I have several devices that I use when I exercise to tell me how I am doing. They do various things from checking how far (or how long) I have been going; how high my heart rate is; how many calories I have burned, etc. Because I have several of these devices, the one I was checking shows only part of the picture. But what it shows is disturbing. It says that, since I moved to Henrietta, I have run 1465 miles during 425 workouts with a duration of 14 days, 13 hours, 14 minutes and 51 seconds. During that time, I have burned 232,898 calories equaling 66.5 pounds. Again, keep in mind that this is one of only 3 devices and that I do not always use them.

Now, here I sit still overweight and of questionable fitness wondering to what benefit this was. While I realize that I am somewhat better off than I would be had I not exercised, as soon as I stop the process for a few weeks, I may as well have never exercised to begin with.

Meanwhile, I also wonder, what if I had used that time for other things. How many people could I have knocked on their door and invited them to study the Bible? How many times could I have read through the Bible? How many prayers could I have said? How many sick could I have visited? In short, what if I had used 349 hours (almost ¼ of a year of working 40 hours a week) for God's glory? How much better off would I be? But again, I need to understand the principle of atrophy. If I do not use it, exercise it and work it, the benefits I have received quickly diminish.

So for this week, the thought is this, exercise the spiritual. Physical exercise is of some benefit but spiritual exercise is of eternal value.
