Preacher's Porch



I was at the YMCA a couple of days ago in the dressing room when the television was turned off. That is to say, someone picked up the remote and intentionally turned it off. Within just a couple of minutes, it was turned back on by someone else. The station was turned to CNN and one of the more prominent political figures of our day was giving a statement and then answering questions about the veteran's health care fiasco that is ongoing.

After just a couple of minutes, someone again picked up the remote and was about to turn the thing off when the person who had tuned in to this station stuck their head around the corner and said they were listening to the broadcast.

The person with the remote replied, "Can I ask you a question? I am not trying to start an argument or pick a fight but I would really like to know, why do you want to listen to that liar tell you lies?"

Person 2 began explaining saying, "I know it. I hate (this person) too. I just want to hear what he's lying about now. I've been listening for ten minutes and he hasn't said anything yet to answer any questions."

That got me thinking. Why DO we want to listen to lies? Especially when we know they are just lies that are aimed at soothing us, deluding us, distracting us, or perverting the truth? Why not quit listening and begin explaining the truth to all who will listen?

Now you may be thinking, "I don't listen to the lies. I filter it all out," or something similar. But I am not talking about politics where we know what is going on. I am talking about our souls and listening to the Father of Lies (Satan) (John 8:44). When Jesus says, "I am THE way, THE Truth and THE life," (John 14:6) why would we choose to listen to anything else?

Yet so many of us so much of the time do this very thing. We believe that we can and should pursue other things to the point of distracting us from our faith. We stay home from worship to watch sports (or play in fantasy leagues), to participate in activities, or to sleep in since Sunday is the only day we have to rest (and even God rested). We commit so much time to the job that we have no time left for family or friends or God. We read our e-mail and Facebook, we send our Instagrams and tweets, we pin it on our wall yet we have no time to read the word of God.

WE ARE LISTENING TO THE LIE! And the problem with that is, when you have heard it enough, you start to question it. You wonder if, maybe it is true and you have missed it. You wonder if there is some underlying truth. You become numb. Remember the first time you heard a state had allowed a homosexual marriage? Remember the outrage? But now that almost half have, do you still feel the same thing? No? Because we become numb.

My thought then is this, instead of listening to the liar to hear what he says, turn him off and tune it to God and His word. That is the source of life. In Him, Todd
