Boy I hate it when that happens! When you just "phone it in" and don't really show up mentally; and then you catch yourself; just after it is a moment too late...the embarrassment is almost equal to the relief the other person can't really "see" you. Now, if you don't know what I am talking about, let me tell you what happened to me recently.

Back about Halloween, Tina and I decided to change electricity providers. The trouble is, it is now almost February and we still haven't received a bill from the new provider. So, I was recently talking to our old provider trying to track down all the relevant information...phone number, account balance, disconnect date, etc. when they began to market their service to me trying to get me to switch back. At that point, I was only half-way listening, thinking instead of what I needed to do next. I zoned out and was "phoning in" my conversation with the person on the phone. I was talking, my mouth was moving, my brain was not.

And so, at the end of the conversation, I said, "Okay, thanks. See you later. Love you. Bye."

My brain caught up at about the same time I heard the person on the other end stifle a snort. I am sure they appreciated the "love you" and the "see you later" both coming from someone they had never met. I was very glad I could simply hang up the phone and end my awkward embarrassment.

But how many times do we do the same thing with our worship to God? How many times do we "zone out" during a sermon, take a "mental vacation" during a prayer, or get caught up in "what-comes-next" and all we have to do instead of being present in the presence of God? How often do we "phone in" what ought to be our moment of refuge and a time to connect to God by simply "going through the motions" without really being engaged mentally and spiritually?

I think there is a reason that the Bible talks so much about God's desire that we seek Him with "all your heart." There is a purpose to the command to love Him with all our soul and mind and strength Continued inside...
