My once new car now has 65,000 miles on it and to top that off, last week, I got a rather excited call from Robert telling me to turn on News Chanel 6 and hurry up because there was a recall on my car that they were talking about. I was already in bed for the night so I just asked him to fill me in. He watched and spoke along with the commentator as they described the recall which was for problems with the steering.

Then my mother called. Same news.

Then I saw it on the News 6 computer home page. Not that I took the time to read the article. I just saw that Hyundai motors had issued a recall for several models of car.

And so it was that, the next time I got in my car, I was listening, feeling, etc., with an extra intensity to all the noises that a car makes. And that was when I heard it...Kalunk, tic, tic, tic, tic, tap, tap, tap. Bang!

Being keenly aware and mechanically inept, I did the only thing I could. I took it in this morning to the dealership to get the work taken care of. The only trouble was, when I got there, they tapped away at their computer and they could find no recall notice for my car. That is where it is so vital to see the church for what it is. It is not a club for the perfect but a hospital for the sick who want to get better. Yes, we have our problems and make our mistakes, but we can't put our focus on the problem or it will seem to grow out of proportion.
