As I began to contemplate an article for this week, it dawned on me that I could not think of anything extraordinary or even really noteworthy that has happened recently. This makes it difficult to write as I prefer to write reflections on my own experiences (or those of my family). Still, I felt compelled to get an article for the bulletin out (even though Selinda has a couple on file to choose from).

But then it dawned on me. This is too often the way that I live my life. Not just me, but all of us. It works like this: Noise! Now that may not make much sense so, let me try to explain.

It is NEVER quiet around my house unless everyone is asleep. If the TV is off, the radio is on. If they are both off, then it is a computer or whistling (Greg or myself) or weird, random noises (Greg and Michelle), humming (Tina), Singing (Amelia), etc. There HAS to be something going on, making noise, etc., or we feel completely...???

I'm not sure what, but it's not normal. We don't really know how to simply "Be still." (Maybe we are afraid someone will think we are sleeping or dead). And that, I am afraid, is how we live our lives publicly as Christians. We cannot ever just stop and let our lives speak for themselves. 1 Timothy 2:2-3 says, "2 Pray for rulers and for all who have authority so that we can have quiet and peaceful lives full of worship and respect for God. 3 This is good, and it pleases God our Savior,"

Now I know that this is talking about fearing persecution. But it is also talking about living our lives in such a way as to not draw persecution by living the word rather than being argumentative and loud. Quiet, peaceful lives rather than living a noisy, messy, frantic life that calls attention to itself. As has been said or thought by many people on many occasions, "I would rather see a sermon any day than to hear one." Doesn't that sound good?

What about you? Do you live your life "out loud?" Or do you simply live the life you have been called to, content in His peace?

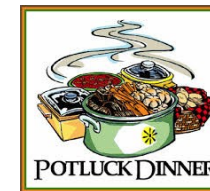
