Wow! What an embarrassment! I hate it when you embarrass yourself and I hate it even worse when it is entirely preventable and yet no one bothers to point out the situation. It is almost as if they are laughing at you because of your calamity. And that is exactly how I felt.

I had just finished umpiring several games at the ball park in Jacksboro during a recent youth tournament where I had called 11-year-old baseball. As you know, it gets kind of hot and humid around here this time of the year and so, after working my assigned games, I was headed home. Now, normally I would change my clothes out of my umpire's outfit and would dress in my street clothes. But, based on the time of day and the lack of good dressing facilities, I opted to just pull off my protective gear...chest protector, leggings, etc., and go home in what I had on. Then I needed gas in the car, so I stopped at the "Lowe's" grocery store in Jacksboro to fuel up and while I was there, decided to go in and get something to eat.

Now, walking around a store on a Saturday evening smelling bad and looking worse is usually enough to cause some unusual looks, but in this case, I saw some people openly staring at me while others would literally turn around in the middle of the aisle and walk away the other way. In fact, not one single person acknowledged me until I was standing at the cash register. Now umpires are not known to be especially lovable, so I wasn't too worried but I did feel kind of funny about it. But, having left a dirty ball field and fixing to eat, I decided I needed to wash up. And it was then that my situation became entirely clear. As I walked into the restroom I glanced into the mirror and immediately noticed that my zipper was all-the-way down and the fly was mostly open. For all intent and purpose, I had been parading around the store in my sports underwear! No wonder people had been going the other way! How embarrassing!!!

And yet I had to question, why hadn't anybody bothered to let me know? Why had they not told me? Surely they had noticed. Many of them had even reacted negatively and with one simple statement or even an appropriate gesture, I could have fixed the situation and made everybody more comfortable. Had they simply not wanted to offend me? Had they been afraid of my reaction? Afraid of me? Were they just too busy to be bothered? Had they hoped someone else would do it? I don't know! But the fact remains; I was the only one who could NOT see what was wrong.

And that sounds just like what happens in the world today. We see people who are lost in sin. And so we have a world full of people dying in their sin because we never bothered to tell them about their problem or the solution.

We have been given a mission and we are therefore missionaries right here at home. Spread the Word. Tell the Truth. Present the Hope. Breathe Life. No excuses.
