When was the last time that you wanted something so badly that you couldn't wait for it to happen? Maybe you lost sleep over it or perhaps you were so anxious you were trembling, but remember that expectation?

In my cross-country program, we generally try to swim at the YMCA about once a week. It is great cardio training with almost no pressure on the joints. Plus, it is just a good change of pace. Now that cross-country has ended, Michelle and I were visiting about life and some of our favorite things. As it turns out, one of hers is swimming (which is why she did cross-country workouts this year). At that point, I happened to mention that I was planning to go to the "Y" the next morning to put my hurt foot in the whirlpool. She quickly told me that she wanted to go and asked if I would take her.

Now, as a parent, I was torn: I know she needs her sleep BUT I also know that fun physical activities are good things so I tried to be sneaky. I told her that, in the morning, IF she would get herself up and IF she would get herself dressed BEFORE I left, I would take her.

So it was that I was pounced at 5:00 this morning bringing me abruptly awake as Michelle told me that she was ready to go. Now, as much as I wanted to tell her to go back to sleep, I had a choice to make. I could be a person of integrity...she had kept her end of the bargain or; I could explain I had been up a good part of the night, make excuses, apologies, and try to go back to bed knowing I had disappointed my daughter. I chose the first, in large part because of her enthusiasm.

But isn't this exactly what the Bible had in mind when it says, "7 I have fought the good fight, I have finished the race, I have kept the faith. 8 Now there is in store for me the crown of righteousness, which the Lord, the righteous Judge, will award to me on that day—and not only to me, but also to all who have longed for his appearing." (2 Timothy 4:8).

Are you living your life with that eager expectation? Are you waking up every day with the hope that maybe today will be the day the promise is fulfilled? Surely our God has much more integrity than I ever could and He will keep His promise.

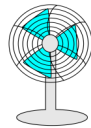


Leroy Schaffner is in rehab in Vernon following a knee replacement.
