Turning the Knob

The story is told of a boy who came home from school one day and noticed that all the vehicles were gone. Realizing that no one was home he just sat on the steps. Soon it began to rain and he got soaked. When his mother came home she asked him why he didn't go into the house. He said, "You weren't home, how could I?" She said, "Honey, the house was unlocked. Did you try turning the knob?"

Friends, the door of the gospel is unlocked. Try turning the knob. Sometimes we make things more difficult than they need to be simply by failing to be observant.
