Scripture: Acts 22:30- Acts 23:2
 30 The commander wanted to find out exactly why Paul was being accused by the Jews. So the next day he released him and ordered the chief priests and all the members of the Sanhedrin to assemble. Then he brought Paul and had him stand before them. 1 Paul looked straight at the Sanhedrin and said, "My brothers, I have fulfilled my duty to God in all good conscience to this day." 2 At this the high priest Ananias ordered those standing near Paul to strike him on the mouth.

Sermon: Let Your Conscience be your Guide?

Point 1: Like many of us, Paul was able to testify that, throughout his life, he had always fulfilled his duty to God in all good conscience. When we read his life story, however, we discover that often his _____ and his conscience were not good measures of his standing with God.

Point 2: While it cannot be questioned that Saul/Paul was passionate about his faith, it is evident that he was wrong in some of his pursuits; even his passionate pursuits. This should serve as notice to us that we need to always check not only our _____ but also our actions to make sure they are in accord with God's plan.

Point 3: Godly wisdom compels us to continually make sure that we are in step with God's will and plan for our life. It equally compels us to admit mistakes and errors, to _____ of sins, to seek _____, and to keep on trying always straining toward the goal.
