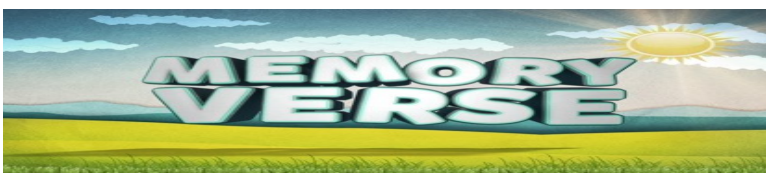
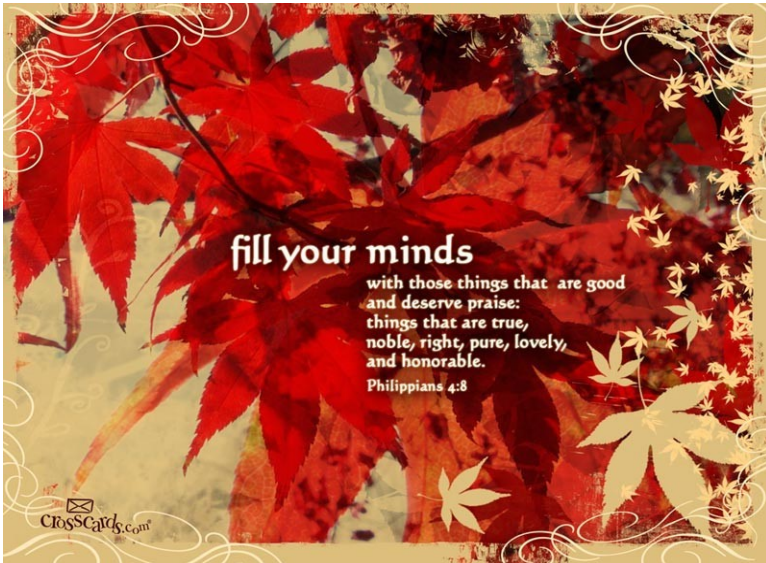
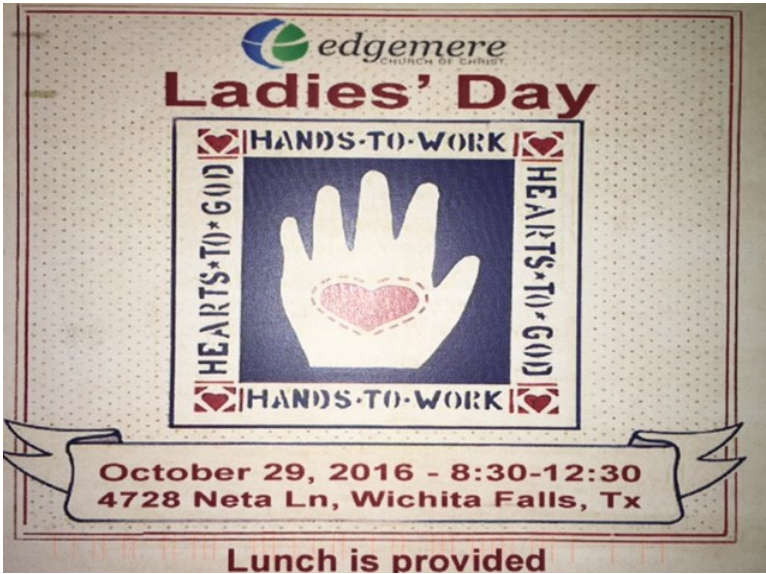
God, His Word, Your Heart
