Men's Bible Study

Every Thursday morning, 6:30 am at the church building.

One of many gifts from God is to be a teacher, Eph. 4:11, for building up the body of Christ, so that all reach maturity and become like Christ.

Becoming a follower of Jesus is not an event that is all encompassing at one's baptism. Baptism is just the beginning of a new relationship with God. Our baptism needs to be followed with learning more about our relationship with God and others.

The Bible is a collection of writings giving us the history of spiritual life and man's unique relationship to God. God created humans in his likeness, i.e. intellect, emotion, and will. God wants humans to seek a relationship with Him, Paul says, "he is not far from us for in Him we live and move and have our very being" (Acts 17:28). So, we search for a relationship through our study of the Holy Scriptures.

Bible classes make our study of scripture a two-fold blessing; one to learn the history and relevance of scripture, and two, to have fellowship with like-minded Christians. It is a great blessing.

Currently Sunday morning sermons are coming form the gospel of Luke. It is a great study of Jesus and first century culture. Using background material enhances our studies and helps us understand the teachings of Jesus. Wednesday evenings I am teaching a class in the auditorium about the Scheme of Redemption; it is a study of the development of the church from the beginning of time up through the first century. On Sunday morning I am teaching the young adult class on Paul's letter to the Romans.

Come, enjoy the fellowship and studies that will bring us closer to God and one another.
