Soul Food

God provides a source of materials to nourish the body which keeps us going and growing. He has provided unlimited amounts of burgers and bananas, but it is up to us to balance our diets. In like manner, our spirits need food. But, what does it mean to; "taste and see that the LORD is good . . ." (Psalm 34:8)? How can we taste the Lord?

Think about this: without regular "soul food," our faith, hope and love do not have the nourishment needed to grow and soon, we find our relationship with God suffering, then we become weak and ineffective and before you know it, we're on our way to spiritual anorexia. Thus, regular feasting on the spiritual provisions God supplies will prevent this from happening.
