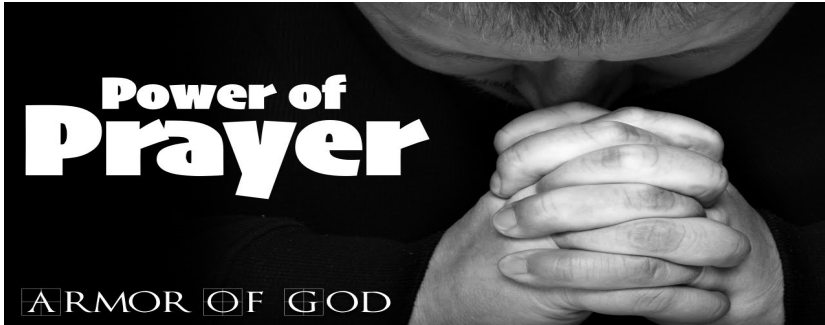

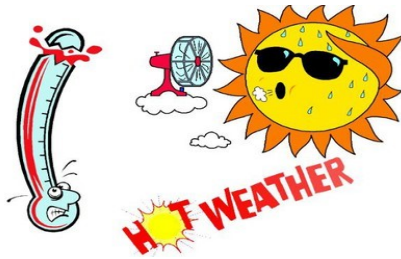

We need to get rid of the guilt we carry by repenting and confessing our sin to God. “If we confess our sins, He who is faithful and just will forgive us our sins and cleanse us from all unrighteousness” (1 John 1:9) . “Confess your sins to one another, and pray for one another, so that you may be healed.” (James 5:16). Confession of sin brings healing to one’s body and soul. Confessing of our sins also heals relationships and encourages fellowship. Confession of sin is good for the physical body and body of Christian believers. Are you struggling with guilt from past sin? Don’t be troubled any longer, confess your sins to God, repent and pray for forgiveness. God will give it immediately.
